About Project Playground:

Playgrounds are a vital component of any healthy community. Originally built to last approximately twenty years, the playgrounds at Norwin School District are in need of a refresh. The District's Master Facilities Study completed by DRAW Collective identified the need to include replacing and upgrading playground equipment during the District's 10-year capital projects plan.

"Project Playground" is a collaborative fundraising initiative between the Norwin School District, the Norwin PTAs, and the Norwin School District Community Foundation. The goal of Project Playground is to construct new community playgrounds and recreational areas that can be used by children during the school day and by the entire community during non-school hours.
