

## JAMIE'S STORY

On Friday, September 21, 1979 at 8:06 a.m. our beautiful daughter, Jamie Lynn, came into this world. She was a sweet, happy and loving child who grew to be the same kind of person as an adult.

Jamie was the oldest of four children. She had three brothers: twins (Chad and Nicholas), were born 18 months after Jamie. Then Jason came along three years after the twins. It was apparent from very early on that Jamie was not going to be pushed around by her brothers. In fact, she bossed them around on a regular basis.

Jamie went to catholic grade school and high school. She graduated college from Penn State with a business degree. She was a very dedicated hard worker and worked at The pt Group from the time she was 17. She loved her job, but she was looking for more to do. She enrolled in Empire Beauty School where she learned to be a nail technician. She immediately loved doing nails and ended up buying a hair salon. She was so happy working at The pt Group half day and the salon the other half.

Her dreams were all coming true. Jamie met Tom Hall in 2006 and they married on September 25, 2010. The whole day was beautiful and both Jamie and Tom were very happy.

They wanted to start a family; Jamie really wanted to be a mom. They realized that it was not going to be as easy as they had hoped. They sought help and went through different treatments and protocols. After a few disappointments, and a very long labor, our beautiful tiny Chloe Elizabeth was born on October 28, 2014. Tom and Jamie were over the moon. They got their sweet, spunky, fun-loving little girl. They felt so blessed to have a beautiful, healthy baby. Chloe was their world and never left Jamie's side. They were together 24/7. Jamie was very protective of her.

After the difficulties of trying to conceive Chloe, they didn't think it was possible to have another baby. But, on Jamie's 38th birthday, they announced they were going to have another child. The whole family was so happy and excited. Chloe was going to be a big sister. On April 7, 2018 our beautiful, healthy Cody Thomas was born by emergency C-section. All seemed well with both Jamie and Cody. They were both discharged after being in the hospital for only two days.

Jamie, Tom, and Chloe were happy as can be. Their little family was complete. They had a girl and a boy, they thought life couldn't get any better. Who would of thought that Jamie had only 38 days to live?

Tuesday, May 15 started out like any other day. It was a beautiful sunny day. Jamie was going shopping for a few last-minute things for Cody's baptism, which was to be the following Sunday. Around 8:15 a.m. tragedy struck. God decided it was time for Jamie to go home to Him, leaving her two beautiful children who she loved with all of her heart. Our precious Jamie: daughter, sister, wife, and mommy, suffered a postpartum hemorrhage and passed away at 1:10 p.m. that day. We were all in shock and disbelief, and are still in denial at times. There is so much devastation all around from losing her. Not just with us, (her family), but with so many relatives, friends and others who knew her in any capacity. We are all lost without her and our lives will never be the same. The Earth has lost a bright light and sweet soul. Heaven has received a blessed angel.

We, her family, are determined to keep her memory alive for her kids and all who knew and loved her. We ask that anyone reading this will always keep our family in your prayers. Every hour of every day is a struggle without her.

## HOW WE HELP

**November 2025** Again this month, there was a need to help Innersight LLC due to the government shutdown. Our donation will allow for the initiation of an emergency food program.

As we do each November, the Foundation also distributed and delivered free hot turkey dinners to local families in need.

Lastly, we contributed to Healthy Habits: a non-profit that equips youth with life-long healthy habits and also supports seniors through wellness and mobility programs.

**October 2025** The Foundation aided Westmoreland Community Action's Christmas for Kids program. The program provides holiday gifts for local families in need and relies on community support through donations and volunteering.

Moreover, we donated to Innersight LLC to fund Jamie's Neighborhood For Grieving Kids services and supplies. Our donation also helped to create a community memorial garden.

**September 2025** This month the Foundation made a donation to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital. St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital's mission is to advance cures and means of prevention for pediatric catastrophic diseases through research and treatment.

**August 2025** We aided the Food 2 Go 4 Kids program via Our Lady of Grace Church. The program provides weekend and holiday food bags for children that qualify for the free and reduced lunches through West Point Elementary school.

**July 2025** This steamy July, the Foundation made a donation to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital. St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital's mission is to advance cures and means of prevention for pediatric catastrophic diseases through research and treatment.

Also this month, we contributed to Autism Speaks. The non-profit works to provide autism research, advocacy, services and support to help people with autism and those who support them thrive. For more information, please visit their website.

Lastly, we aided the American Diabetes Association in their fight against juvenile diabetes.

**June 2025** This month, a donation was made to Circle Camps. The Camp's mission is to provide a free summer camp for girls who have experienced the death of a parent. Their goal is to help prepare girls to become confident young women while dealing with the loss of a parent. The donation provides items the campers will need for this upcoming season.

**May 2025** This month, the Foundation aided our local Greater Latrobe School District. We were informed of many overdue account balances for students' meals. Although elementary schools and junior high schools receive the benefit of free breakfasts and lunches within our state, the Senior High School is not able to provide free meals. We were pleased to provide relief to students and their families in need.

**April 2025** This spring we contributed to the Latrobe 4th of July Celebration. The 501(c)(3) charity sets forth to provide free, community-focused holiday experiences, services for veterans and low income community members and this year it will introduce youth-oriented initiatives. We are pleased to help with their new endeavor!

Additionally, the Foundation made a donation to the Compassionate Friends- Greensburg Chapter. The group is a self-help organization offering friendship, understanding, and hope to bereaved families that have experienced the death of a child.

**March 2025** This month we aided Tunnel to Towers Foundation's Gold Star Family Home Program. The program honors the legacy of those who made the ultimate sacrifice while serving our country and provides a mortgage-free home to surviving spouses with young children.

Also, we (once again) teamed up with Shannon Reid, director of the First Presbyterian Church preschool, to amplify her annual Easter for Eli Easter basket drive. Easter for Eli is a campaign that collects Easter baskets for sick children in the memory of Eli Garrett, who died of cancer in 2009.

Moreover, we donated to Innersight LLC for both Annual Children's Grief Awareness Day festivities and Jamie's Neighborhood For Grieving Kids Summer Grief Camp. Our donation will cover art supplies, books, take-home materials, and the snacks/drinks/plates/cups/cutlery for the children and their families.

Lastly, we made a contribution to Clelian Heights. The school has a specially designed program that provides highly structured classroom instruction allowing children with a variety of intellectual and/or developmental disabilities—including those on the autism spectrum—to participate in educational and social activities within an environment that both challenges and supports their limitations and abilities.

**February 2025** A donation was made to Birthright of Johnstown. Birthright is an organization that supplies new moms in need with supplies, clothes and other necessary items for their newborn babies. Jamie had such a strong love for all children and always wanted to help those who were disadvantaged in any way.

**January 2025** We made a donation to Amanda's Heart Foundation to kick off 2025. AHF is committed to providing assistance to individuals with physical, intellectual, mental, and/or developmental disabilities and autism, their families, and the staff members who support them.

We also teamed up with Friends to Friends, Inc. The organization strives to bring awareness of adults and children with disabilities through community interaction.
